

Juknokwon (Bamboo Garden) & Jeonju Hanok Village

Juknokwon (Bamboo Garden): Juknokwon in Damyang is a bamboo forest cultivated by the town of Damyang. The bamboo forest at approximately 160,000 m² in size was formed in May 2003. The rock steps and winds blown between the bamboo trees provide relief from daily stress. Try bamboo leaf tea for a perfect end the visit.

Jeonju Hanok Village: It is the largest traditional hanok village in Korea, with more than 700 hanoks in the area around Pungnam-dong, Jeonju, and is the only downtown Hanok-gun in the country. As an important space in the development process of modern residential culture in Korea, which began in 1910, important cultural properties such as Gyeonggijeon, Omokdae, Hyanggyo, and about 20 cultural facilities are scattered. This is Korea's representative travel destination.
