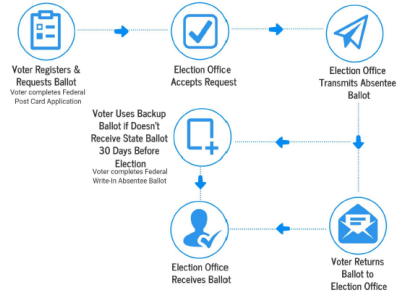

Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA)

U.S. citizens have a fundamental right to vote that is afforded protection by the Constitution. UOCAVA allows eligible citizens to register to vote and request an absentee ballot using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA).

The FVAP ensures Service Members have the tools and resources to vote from anywhere in the world. Stop by the A&FRC to register to vote for federal, state and local elections, and to learn more about the overseas voting process.

Open to all DoD-Affiliated Noncombatant Personnel Ensures Evacuation Readiness for all Team Osan from Assembly Point (AP) to Repatriation

- * NEO briefings offered quarterly
- * NEO Binder and Gas mask inspections
- * Opportunity to practice AP procedures twice yearly
- * Coordinates Base NEO Warden Network & Information Flow

We Take Care of Our Air Force Families

Emergency Family Assistance Center- A Disaster Response Unit assesses and provides for needs of families & service members in unlikely natural disasters or events.

Exceptional Family Member Program- Information and Referrals on available services for families in cooperation with the base clinic

Casualty Assistance Response & Air Force Families Forever- Support for families of service members that have died while on active duty

Transition Assistance Program

Mandatory Veterans Opportunity to Work Act workshops starting one year prior to separation or two years before retirement. Call early to signup and save your seat. Workshops include:

- * **Pre-Separation Briefing**
- * **Transition Goals, Plans, Success** 5-Day TAP Workshop (includes VA Benefits I & II and Department of Labor 3-day Employment Workshop)
- * **Capstone** (complete NLT 90 days prior to last day of military service)

Optional Tracks Offered by A&FRC and Partnering Agencies

- * **Career Technical Training-** A two-day course taught by our Department of Labor contractor, focusing on analyzing your skillset and understanding your specific labor market
- * **Accessing Higher Education-** A one-day course at the Education Center looking into various educational options for your intended career path and utilizing your GI Bill Benefits
- * **Entrepreneurship (Boots to Business)-** A two-day course taught by a SBA-approved business owner with information on how to market, setup and plan out your business model
