III. Opening Remarks: Colonel McKibban welcomed attendees and underscored the openness of the discussion to various topics.

IV. Agenda:

- a) Ms. April Kersey, School Liaison Program Manager, provided an overview of her role and discussed:

- b) Ms. Allysse Struhs, Osan Elementary School Principal, discussed OES enrollment and events for April.
 - a. Communication improvements

- c) Dr. Jacob Sherwood, DoDEA Pacific West Superintendent, spoke on Universal Pre-K implementation and related initiatives.
 - a. Transportation arrangements
 - b. Staffing updates
 - c. Pacific West is the only region in which all schools will offer Universal Pre-K starting August 2024
 - d. CDC wrap-around care survey
- d) Mrs. Tiffany Bryant and Dr. Macitia Ekeh, OMHS, discussed various school-related matters.
 - a. Testing administration
 - b. Month of the Military Child (MOMC) events
 - c. Spring Sports and Fine Arts events
 - d. Senior Decision Day and Graduation Venue Change
 - i. Col McKibban briefed that 51 FW has identified potential alternative venues for OMHS Graduation and DoDEA was in the process of selecting the best location. Static display aircraft would be made available on Graduation Day for pictures at the request of OMHS, regardless of venue.
- e) Mrs. Marilyn Martin-Han, Flight Chief for Child & Youth Programs, briefed on CYP events and initiatives.

- f) Capt Jagoda, Housing Representative, discussed CE housing projects and initiatives.
 - a. Updates on ongoing projects
 - b. OSD tenant satisfaction survey
 - c. PTD and bike round-up
- g) Maj Gray, Director of Staff, briefed recent updates to the Mustang One-Stop and upcoming touchpoints that fall under the Wing's Communication Action Plan.

V. Open Forum Q&A:

a) **Question:** Is there a reason why there is no curb ramp by Checkertails or are there plans to put a ramp in near the area?

Answer: Capt Jagoda responded that CE would review the request and look for opportunities to install curb ramps at key sidewalk locations in the near future.

b) Question: Has OES received feedback from staff for assessments?

Answer: Ms. Struhs responded that in the beginning of the year staff had some difficulty due to it being their first time, and by the middle of the year, the staff were apprehensive but able to see growth. Now the staff are approaching the end of the year, they are excited.

c) **Question:** Is there a plan to add Godeok area to the bus route, what is the timeline, and is it potential to start next year?

Answer: Col Grygo responded LRS is evaluating bus capacity to see if another route can be added. Results due in May.

d) **Question:** Is Pre-K capped at a certain number?

Answer: Dr. Sherwood responded that a study in Iwakuni showed not every parent decided to send their eligible child to Pre-K, and DoDEA developed a formula based on the study, which estimates OES needs three Pre-K rooms; however, they are postured and ready to grow into a fourth, as necessary.

- e) **Question:** What is the process for licensing and hiring for Pre-K? **Answer:** Dr. Sherwood stated applicant's teaching degree must include early childhood education. He also mentioned that DoDEA has a new HR Director who has been great with hiring teachers and carrying over state licensing.
- f) **Question:** How can parents better view DoDEA AI? **Answer:** Dr. Sherwood explained that DoDEA AI can be accessed through the DoDEA website.
- g) **Question:** Is the OMHS Graduation venue location change a Wing or DoDEA decision? **Answer:** Col McKibbon explained the operational safety concerns are driving the Graduation venue change. The WLT is an unsafe industrial area and is unsuitable for these types of events. The team has identified potential alternatives and has committed to ensuring aircraft static displays are available for photos.
- h) **Question:** Will buses for Pre-K and Godeok work together? Will OES be able to accommodate Pre-K?

Answer: Dr. Sherwood responded DoDEA anticipates being able to accommodate all Command Sponsored families. DoDEA cannot legally staff for Space-A families but will accommodate as possible. Transportation will not get an additional bus to accommodate Pre-K or Godeok, but are assessing ways to optimize to meet those requirements. They will meet the car seat requirements for Pre-K children.

- i) **Question:** Will the CDC be transporting Pre-K students to OES for before and after care? **Answer:** Ms. Marilyn Martin-Han responded that FSS is currently assessing opportunities to meet this requirement.
- j) Question: Have the tiny bugs in the commissary park and OES grounds been addressed? Answer: Capt Jagoda responded that she would pass the issue to Entomology for action. Follow-Up: 51 CES Entomology determined the small bugs were common stink bugs that had hatched due to the warm weather. These bugs are common to Korea and are harmless.
- k) **Discussion:** MDG representative briefed that school sports physicals will take place at the end of April, May, and June.
- 1) All leaders in attendance were made available for questions after meeting close.
