

Your Disability Counts!






The President has charged Federal agencies to recruit and retain individuals with disabilities. You were offered the opportunity to provide disability information on the SF-256, Self-Identification of Disability, when you on-boarded Federal Service. Self-Identification of disability status is essential for effective data collection and analysis of the Federal government's efforts. Updating your disability status provides the Department of the Air Force with data to identify programs or services needed today and in the future to support its employees with disabilities.

Self-Identification is voluntary and your cooperation in providing accurate information is critical. Your information remains confidential. It is not revealed to your supervisor and does not go in your personnel file.

Many employees forget to update their disability status as their health status changes. Has your disability status changed since you on-boarded? It's easy to update.
