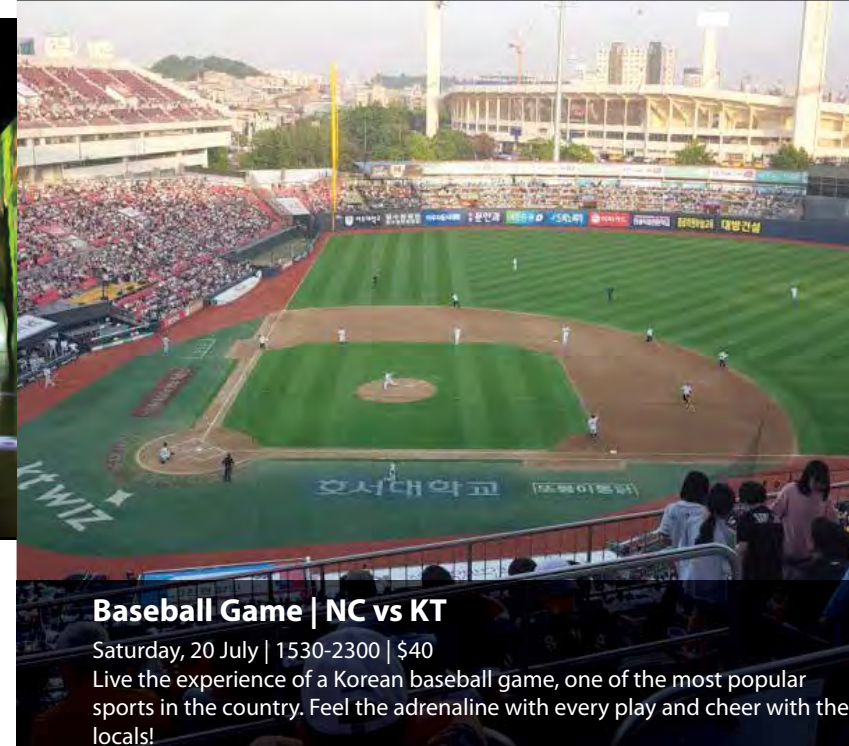

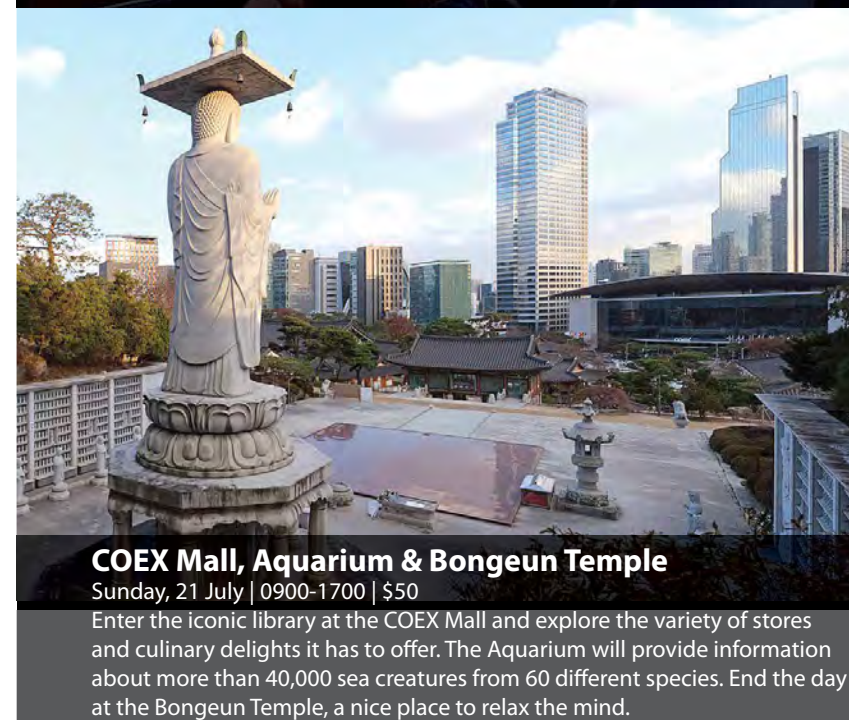

The Mustang Community Center is conveniently located across from the Fitness Center. Inside, you'll find a variety of activities, events, and equipped rooms for everyone to enjoy:

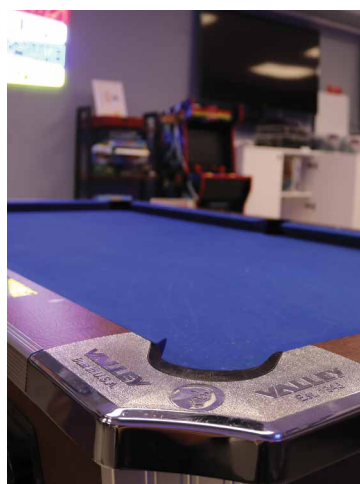
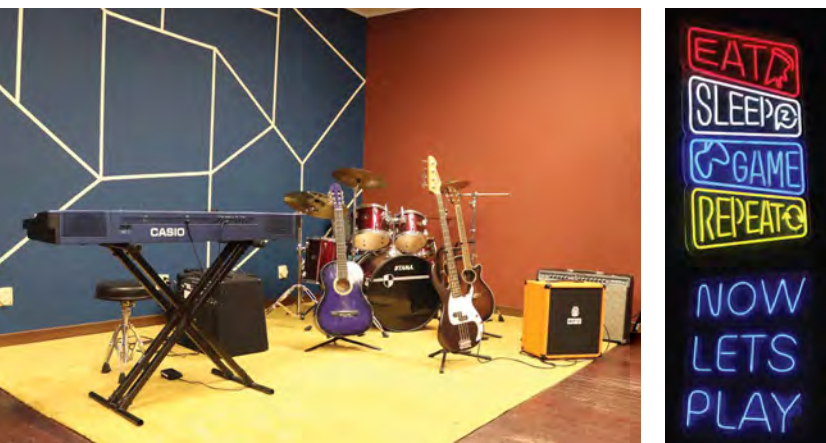
