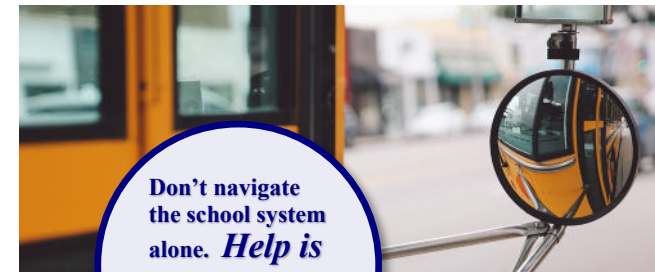

Assess needs, develop service plans to meet family goals and objectives



## Improve

Offer educational opportunities to empower families and improve quality of life



## Collaborate

Collaborate with on and off base partners such as School Liaisons



## Provide

Provide IEP/504 eligibility support



## Consultation

Provide advice and consultation on IEP/504 and dispute resolutions
